

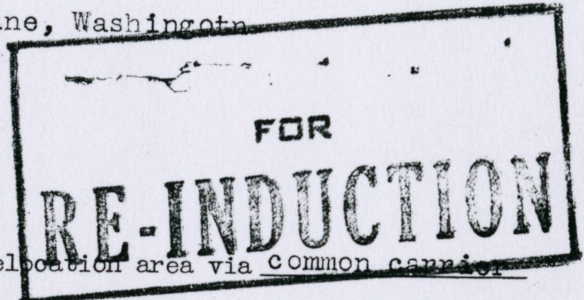
WAR RELOCATION AUTHORITY
ALIEN'S SHORT-TERM LEAVE

This is to certify that Iku Honiuchi, an alien of Japanese nationality residing in Block No. 21-6-A within Minidoka Relocation Area is allowed to leave such area on July 8,, 1944, to go to:

Spokane, Washington

for the following purposes:

and is required to return to such relocation area via COMMON CARRIER as soon as such purpose has been achieved, and in any event to reach such area by _____ M., on August 8,, 1944. No delay and no travel not necessary to the above purpose is authorized. This leave is subject to the terms of the regulations of the War Relocation Authority relating to issuance of leave for departure from a relocation area and subject to any special conditions or restrictions set forth on the reverse side hereof.

Travel to the first destination shown above and return from the last destination has been permitted by the Department of Justice. Travel to the second destination may take place only with the permission of the United States Attorney at Spokane and travel to other destinations shown above may take place only with the approval of the United States Attorney of the judicial district including the new point of departure.
