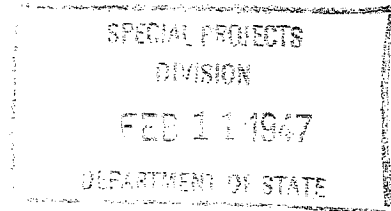

HIYOGO
For your information and the completion of your Japanese records, this is to advise that the Japanese aliens, ICHIRO TANAKA and HIYOGO HATAYAMA, departed for Japan from the Port of San Francisco aboard the SS "General Gordon" on January 31, 1947, en route to Yokohama. Both of these aliens were removed from the U. S. Public Health Service Hospital at Lexington, Kentucky, for return to Japan. For your additional information, Mr. Tanaka is a former alien enemy who, prior to his hospitalization, was interned at the Santa Fe, New Mexico, Internment Camp. Mr. Hatayama is an alien Japanese who, prior to his hospitalization, was located at the Colorado River Relocation Center.
