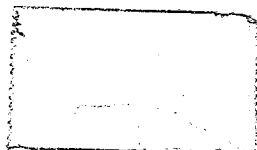

Dear Mr. Clattenburg:

For your information and records, there are enclosed herewith three copies of a list of the names of the 354 Japanese aliens who were repatriated from our Fort Lincoln (North Dakota) Internment Camp. It is desired to point out that the last page of this list need not be considered in conjunction with the list of repatriated aliens from Fort Lincoln, inasmuch as it contains the names of Japanese aliens who are not alien enemy internees but immigration deportation cases from our Chicago District who were removed from the United States under outstanding warrants of deportation in their cases at the same time as the Japanese internees who were repatriated. In this connection, there are also attached separately for your information three copies of the list of the 11 Japanese aliens from the Chicago District who were deported to Japan under immigration proceedings. All necessary deletions have been made in these lists.

Also enclosed for your information and records are three copies of the list (all necessary deletions having been made thereon) of the names of the 325 Japanese aliens who were repatriated from our Santa Fe (New Mexico) Internment Camp. For your information, there is listed at end of these 325 names the name of a female deportation case from Phoenix, Arizona, one Shizu Morita, 43 years old, born in Japan, who was included with the repatriates as a deportation case. This Office is not in possession of any further information concerning this individual at the present time.

Enclosed also are three copies of the list (in three parts entitled Group 1 containing 132 names, Group 2 containing



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35 names and Group 4 containing 3,388 names) of the names of the 3,555 Japanese aliens who were repatriated from the Tule Lake War Relocation Center, Newell, California. All necessary deletions have been made thereon.

In addition to the attached copies of sailing lists, it is desired to call attention to the fact that the following 29 Japanese alien enemy internees and deportees from the Los Angeles District were included in this sailing. The usual copies of sailing lists were not submitted by the Los Angeles office and the following information concerning the 29 aliens as furnished us by that office is listed below.
