Memorandum to All Shareholders in the Fujii Company.

The claims of the Fujii Company and its shareholders for losses sustained during the evacuation program have been submitted to the Department of Justice on the affidavits and forms prepared by Kenji Fujii.

An offer of compromise has been submitted to me by the government in the total amount of \$8,252.50 for all losses sustained by the company and its shareholders, with each individual claimant's share as follows:

Kenji Fujii	1,959.85
Mary Halpern	2,166.65
Kimiko Fujii	1,031.50
Sumiko Fujii	1,031.50
Hanako Fujii	1,031.50
Katsuyo Domoto	<u>1,031.50</u>
Total:	<u>8,252.50</u>

In order to complete the submission of this matter and obtain a settlement I will need from each claimant a signed offer of compromise (the original of which is enclosed) and from each claimant, other than Kenji Fujii, a completely executed Form ECSF-1.

I am enclosing, for each such claimant, two copies of that Form, filled in as far as I am able from information in my possession. Attached to that form is a sheet indicating specifically what information is to be added. Please fill in that additional information before you sign the Form; then sign it and have your signature sworn to before a Notary Public and return the original to me, keeping the copy of the Form for your records.

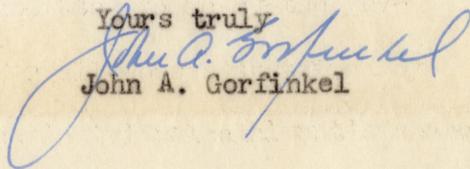
If you were married at the time of evacuation, the offer of compromise must also be signed by your husband, and the marital status form (two copies of which are enclosed, must also be filled in and signed
