

ARMY PURPOSE HERE IS TO REGISTER CITIZENS

LT. CARROL SAYS CHOICE CANNOT BE REMADE AFTER ONCE DONE

Lt. Carroll of the Army Registering Team emphatically stated that the team is here merely for the purpose of completing the registration of all male citizens 17 years of age and over, in an interview with a Dispatch reporter yesterday.

"Any person filling out the form answers the questions according to his own choice. The team will not influence him in his choice. If he answers 'no' to question #28, he is made to realize the significance of his choice and is told he will never again have the chance to remake his choice," he added.

Rumors to the effect that if a registrant answers 'no' to 27, he cannot answer 'yes' to #28 was refuted by Lt. Carroll. "Registrants may," he emphasized, "answer 'no' to #27 and still answer 'yes' to #28". He also said that the team will not influence registrants in answering the questions.

RATION BOOKS . . .

THOSE SEEKING TO RESETTLE WILL APPLY BEFORE LEAVING

Procedure for obtaining Ration Books for those colonists who are about to be released from the centers for outside employment was issued by the Office of Price Administration.

Arrangement will be made so that the evacuees will be able to obtain

their books before leaving the Project.

The establishment of a board to review the applications in accordance with rationing regulation is being contemplated.

Because of the time required to complete steps preliminary to issuing books, evacuees should apply for books at the same time as applying for clearance, although they will not be issued until the leave is authorized.

NURSES AIDE FEELS HOSPITAL WORK CONTRIBUTES TO COLONY

"You cannot begin to realize what a sense of satisfaction sweeps over you in knowing that you are really contributing your bit towards the welfare of the community," Yuki Fukumitsu, a new nurses' aide, said.

"I admit taking care of patients isn't a clean job--nor is it an easy job--but are you forever and a day going to search for only the easy job?" stated Miss Fukumitsu.

No position in the Project will improve one's financial status, but being a nurses' aide certainly can contribute towards your well being," she added, "I don't re-

gret taking this job."

"Those patients in the hospital are our people and they need us."

At present, 30 nurses' aide are wanted immediately at the hospital wards. A nurses' aide is entitled to take advance training course leading her to a certificate as practical nurse. She is required to take a state board examination which will make her eligible in the states of New York and California.

CITIZEN REPATRIATE REGISTRATION

All citizens, both male and female, 17 years of age and over, must register whether or not they have or intend to apply for repatriation. This is the word received late yesterday by Mr. Coverley from Washington, D.C.

The policy with reference to aliens has not been changed. Aliens who have already applied for repatriation will not be required to register. This was announced by the Army team last week.

CITIZENS

There is some misunderstanding, however, with regard to citizens. Citizens who wish to apply for repatriation but have not yet done so must first register, but such registration will not deprive them of the privilege of later applying for repatriation after the present registration program has been completed.

Citizens, both male and female, 17 years of age and over, who have

already applied for repatriation and have not registered on the day prescribed for registration must register on Monday and Tuesday, February 22 and 23.

No requests for repatriation forms from citizens, either male or female, 17 years of age and over, will be issued unless the applicant presents a registration certificate. This certificate will be issued to all registrants at the time of their registration.

REPATRIATE

Persons who have already obtained registration blanks but who have not yet filled them in will not be permitted to file their application

for repatriation until after the registration program has been completed. In other words, the distribution of repatriation blanks and acceptance of completed repatriation forms will be resumed at the same time, but not before March 1. This is necessary because of the work involved in the citizen registration program.

Therefore,

(1) All citizens, male and female, 17 years and over must register.

(2) Applications for repatriation may then be made by anyone after March 1.

(3) Applications for repatriation will not be issued without a card showing that they have registered.
