COMBAT UNIT WILL HAVE FOUR COMPONENTS

The combat team, of Americans of Japanese ancestry, to which qualified volunteers will be assigned, will have the customary infantry, artillery, engineer, and medical components, and will be trained for combat service in an active theatre, the Army officials said.

Company officers will be of Japanese ancestry, to the extent that men with the requisite military experience can be found. From time to time their number will be augmented by graduates from officer candidate schools. Opportunity for attendance at service schools and for promotion to higher grades will be open to all enlisted and commissioned personnel on the same basis as for the rest of the Army.

If found qualified, the individual may expect to be inducted from 30 to 60 days after volunteering. Those rejected for physical reasons will be given assistance in getting jobs in war plants.

INUKAI, DISPATCH MIMEOGRAPHER CRANKS 4800 COPIES IN 42 MINUTES

A world record in mimeograph operation was believed to have been established Thursday afternoon when a DISPATCH mimeographer, Harry Inukai, cranked out 4800 copies in 42 minutes with one helper, Toki Kumata, feeding the paper.

On the basis of this record, it may be calculated that Inukai's speed was about 115 turns to a

minute or about two copies per second.

Ordinarily, it takes about one and half hour to two hours to print 4800 sheets by hand-cranking the mimeograph.

The DISPATCH readers may now appreciate the fact the amount of physical labor it requires to print four to six page daily with a circulation of 4800.

TSUTSUI WILL PROBABLY TAKE AYE POINT TITLE

With three of the top five Class A scorers through with their schedule for the outdoor basketball season, Miks' Tak Tsutsui seems to have the scoring crown cinched as he is only two points behind leading John Kashiwabara of the Waks.

Kashiwabara has 97 points for the season and Tsutsui has only to make 3 markers to take the point-making title.

The only other player who has even the slightest chance is Placers' high-scoring center George Goto, but he will have to loop in at least 25 counters. It just can't be done against the Miks.

One interesting fact is that Tsutsui will be the only leading scorer out of the five who played all of the 8 games scheduled in the league for each team.

Therefore he must dump in at least 17 points if his average per game is to be equal to that of Kashiwabara, who has a 16 plus average for each contest.

QUESTION 28 SUBSTITUTED

Question 28 to Form 126-Revised has been changed substantially, in a teletype message received by Harvey Coverley, project director, from Dillon S. Myer, national director, in Washington at 3:34 o'clock Friday afternoon.

The special telegram was received from Washington when the City Council and Planning Board were having an emergency meeting at #1308 on this vital point of the questionsaire.

The complete text of the telegram from Director Myer said:

"THE following question shall be substituted for question 28 in Form 126

Revised for aliens: 'Will you swear to abide by the Laws of the United States and to take no action which would in any way interfere with the war effort of the United States?' Aliens may, however, answer the present Question 28, if they prefer, either by a straight Yes or No or by a qualified answer. The substitute Question 28 may also be answered by aliens in a qualified way if they so desire. The substitute Question 28 should be a mimeographed slip, attached to Form 126 Revised.
