Evacuees who receive injuries in the course of employment by the WRA, or while traveling between their home in the Center and the place of work, are entitled to compensation in accordance with the provisions of the United States Employees ing for residents Compensation Act. The heirs of evacuees killed under such circumstances are also entitled to receive benefits under the Act.

> Injured workers, whose benefits under the Compensation Act, are insufficient to enable them to support themselves and their families, may apply for and receive public assistance grants.


