1942 - Aug. 19 - Evacuation "Editor" came out just before war. (Some saying Wash. to Wyoming, Oregon to Idaho. Those days of waiting were spent fast.

1942 - Aug. The all center dance was held in the lobby. The dance was from 8:30 to 12:30 next morning at 4 AM work in milk house. One does to be remembered took picture of the

19 families to come into the center - some had a queer feeling having soldiers guard us all around the road. We got 2 pictures in the paper now but!!
