

Distribute October-November Clothing Checks

October-November clothing allowance checks for those whose names begin from A-N are being distributed by the block administrators in their respective blocks beginning this morning. John A. Nelson, administrative services officer, announced.

October salary checks for maintenance division, activity 400, and supplementary September payroll for activities 200, 300 and 900 will be distributed in the same manner. Public assistance grants are also delivered by the block administrators. Those who have applied for such grants but do not receive checks from the block administrators may call at the timekeeper's desk in the administration building for their payments which will be made in cash.

Unemployment compensation for November are being paid in cash at the timekeeper's desk in the administration building. Unemployment compensation for December will not be paid until January except to those whose eligibility was terminated in December. In the latter cases, cash payments will be made.

Any dispute in regard to clothing allowance checks must be referred to the social welfare office at 24-26. Disputes as to the amount of the October pay checks must be settled with the timekeeper's section in the administration building, Nelson said.

Draft Sign-up Begins Tomorrow for 16-Year Olds

Selective Service registration of all male residents born between July 1, 1924, and Dec. 31, 1924, will be conducted beginning Wednesday, Dec. 23, at 24-26 from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. It is mandatory that all within this age group register as those failing to register will be subject to prosecution by any United States attorney and subject to fine or imprisonment or both, John A. Nelson, administrative services officer, warned. Registration schedule is as follows:

Those who reached 16 years of age in July or August of 1942 will register on Dec. 23, 24 and 26.

Those who reached 18 years of age in September or October of 1942 will register on Dec. 23 and 29.

Those who reached or will reach 18 years of age in November or December of 1942 will register on Dec. 30 and 31.

All men in the age groups 18-20 or 45-64 who have not previously registered for selective service can comply with the order during the registration period.
