

Ban Inflammable Decorations Around Light Bulbs

No inflammable decorations should be used directly around light bulbs, but fire-resisting material or protector can be used if placed three to four inches ~~away~~ from the light, Jess Mason, associate fire protection officer, announced.

Ashes from the coal stoves must be extinguished on the ground to insure against unnecessary accidents, Mason said.

Release Information on Mailing of Letters

Pete Fujioka, postal supervisor, released the following information concerning the mailing of letters:

When mailing letters always write the full name, proper address, city and state.

If there is a change in residence, notify your former sub-station. Newspapers and magazines should be also notified.

Always include your address on the envelope. Dead letters average about 12 each week at the local post office.

All important mail should be registered. Packages may also be insured for proper protection.

If loose change is mailed, wrap the coin in paper or tape it on cardboard so it will not move around in the envelope.
