Ban Inflamable Decorations Around Light Bulbs

No inflamable decorations should be used directly around light bulbs, but fireresisting material or protector can be used if placed three to four inches and from the light, Jess Mason, associate fire protection officer, announced.

Ashes from the coal stoves must be extinguished on the ground to insure against unecessary accidents, Mason said.
