

Army Extends Opportunity for Qualified Nisei to Enlist

Pleased with its success and with the high calibre of nisei recruited at the relocation centers for special training, the Army is again planning to select for its Army Language school at Savage, Minnesota, an additional class of 250 enlisted men. The excellent performance of the men who volunteered for this service from the relocation centers during the past year justifies the Army's plan to enlist an additional class of nisei for a new course of specialized Japanese language instruction beginning July 1.

This further opportunity for voluntary enlistment of American citizens of Japanese ancestry into the Army for training as Japanese language specialists is being extended to nisei who can meet the following qualifications. Both single and married men are eligible.

1. Applicants must be male citizens of the United States, of draft age and physically fit for induction into the United States Army.

2. While applicant should preferably be a graduate of either an American high school or of a Japanese Middle School (Chugakko), he must possess a fundamental knowledge of both the English and Japanese languages. Candidates must be conversant with both languages. He must have adequate command of the Japanese language, both oral and written. He should have facile use of "Hiragana", "Kata-kana", and a good number of "Kanji" normally used in written Japanese.

Men meeting the above qualifications will be given the opportunity of volunteering for enlistment in the United States Army. Interviewing teams will be visiting this center in the near future, and further detailed information may be had from them.

Men found linguistically qualified will be given a cursory physical examination by the project doctor and if physically qualified he will be instructed to appear before a local board for voluntary induction into the military service. On arrival at the Army Language school, Savage, Minnesota, the candidate will be given an intensive but complete six months' language specialist course, and upon completion of the course will be sent out into the field with combat troops. The duties are definitely not of "espionage" nor "secret agent" type of work. A limited number of students who show special aptitude and temperament for teaching will be retained at school as enlisted instructors with rating of sergeants or better.

All interested applicants are requested to fill out a qualification form at the project director's office prior to the arrival in your center of the interviewing team. Men who have filled out the form will be instructed to present themselves for interview at the time of the interviewing team's visit. Successful candidates will be processed at an armed force induction center in time to assure their assignment and arrival at the Army Language School, Savage, Minnesota, not earlier than June 25, nor later than July 1.

Ban Kite Flying in Dangerous Areas

Will you please have any interested woman contact this office at once and enclose with her letter a copy of her WRA form 26. 陸軍日本語學校志願兵募集

ミネソタ州のサウエヂ陸軍語學校の成功とその特殊訓練の爲各轉任所より募集された二世兵の技能に鑑み米國陸軍では同學校に入る志願兵を更に二百五十名選抜すべく再計畫中である。昨年の各轉任所よりの志願兵の優秀を成績は七月一日から更に日本語特別訓練の爲二世入學者を募集する今回の陸軍案をもたらせたものである。日系市民が陸軍に志願して日本語特別兵として訓練を受ける今回の新機會は次の資格を具備した二世に開かれてあるものである。

一 志願兵は徵兵適齡の男子米國民市民で陸軍に入營可能の健康体の持主でなければならぬ。獨身者も妻帯者も志願出来る。二 米國ハイスクール又は日本中學校の卒業生が歓迎されるが何れにしても志願者は英語と日本語の基本知識を備へ兩語を話し且つ書く普通能力を持つ

たをければならない。日本語では片假名と平假名によく通じ、常用漢字を相當知つてゐるべきである。

右の資格にかなふ者が今回の志願機會を與へられるのであるが志望者と面談の爲、陸軍徵募官一行が近日當センターを來訪する筈であるから明細な説明はその際得られるであらう。兩國語知識の資格を具備すると見做された者は所内の醫師に依つて簡単な身体検査を受け、その合格者は志願入營の爲地方徵兵局(ローカル・ボード)に出頭を命ぜられる。サウエヂ陸軍語學校に入つた後は六ヶ月間にわたり日本語特別兵として速成にして完全な訓練を受け、卒業後は戰鬪部隊と共に出征するものであるが、その任務は絶体に間諜や密偵の如き性質のものではない。入學者中教師の才能と性格を持つと見做される者は同學校に軍人教師として留めるが此の場合には最低軍曹の位階を與へられる。志願希望者は陸軍徵募官

一行がセンターに來訪する以前に所長事務所に出頭して資格に關する書式を作成されたい。行來所と共に志望者は面談の爲呼出され、合格者には陸軍語學校に今年の六月廿五日から七月一日の間に到着、入學する間に合ふ様に入營者一時集合所(インダクシヨン・センター)にて手續をとられる。
