Warning Against Improper Use of Official Stationery

Warning was issued by Dillon S. Myer, WRA director, for against the use of official stationery for personal correspondence. Memorandum received here reads as follows:

All employees of the War Relocation Authority and all evacuees in Relocation Centers are reminded of the regulation that Government property may not be put to unofficial or personal use.

In particular, official stationery and envelopes of the Government must never be used for personal correspondence. Even though the Relocation Program may be discussed in the letter, the correspondence is personal unless written by an employee of the Authority in line with and in furtherance of his official duties.

Furthermore, the use of official stationery for personal correspondence creates the impression that the correspondence is official and represents the views of the Authority, and this may have embarrassing results for the Relocation Program.

# \$100 Household Exemption Allowable on California Tax

Any resident from California whose legal residence as of March 2, 1942, was within a county in which personal property tax bills were levied without an exemption on household goods up to an assessed valuation of \$100 may apply for householders exemption or for a refund to the value of \$100, according to a release from Victor L. Furth, acting chief of the evacuee property office, San Francisco, to James H. Porter, evacuee property officer here.

In a recent ruling made by the Attorney General for California, evacuees temporarily residing outside of the State are nevertheless entitled to an exemption of personal property taxes on household goods up to an assessed valuation of \$100. In preparing 1943 personal property tax bills some counties gave taxpayers the benefit of this exemption while others did not. Any evacuee questioning the amount of his 1943 personal property tax bill is advised to determine whether or not he has been granted the householders exemption if he is entitled to it, addressing a request to the county assessor with an affidavit attached setting forth the facts regarding his legal residence as of March 2, 1942.

## Work Clothing Will No Longer Be Issued

Supplementary work clothing will no longer be issued by the social welfare department, Virgil Payne, social welfare director, disclosed.

According to latest administrative instructions from Dillon S. Meyer, WRA director, clothing such as sanitary caps and aprons, gloves, coveralls will be provided through divisional supervisors to the proscribed classes of workers and shall be considered part of the division or section work-crow equipment. Return of worn-out items shall be required before new issuance are made.

## Gala Fourth of July Public Dance Slated

A gala Fourth of July dance, strictly for couples only, sponsored by the recreation department, will be given in the high school gym at 8 p.m. Saturday, July 3.

Admission will be free. The first hour will be devoted to square dancing under the supervision of the members of the recent leadership training classes.
