Regulations for obtaining shoe ration cards will adhere hereafter to the national OPA policy, Shig Masunaga, head of the block managers' group, announced. The recent restrictions imposed on center residents by the Wyoming OPA have been eased through the efforts of the managers, Masunaga said. All persons making application for special shoe ration stamps are requested to use their full names on the applications since they must be checked against the files. Use of nicknames or incomplete names has resulted in confusion.
