#1306--1 man to handle automobile parts. Up to \$50 per week, depending on ability and experience. Madison, Wis.

#1317--1 male stock room clerk. No experience needed. \$25 per week, good prospects for promotion. 40 to 44 hours per week, time and half over 44. Chicago.
