

Messages to Japan Will Be Accepted Tomorrow

Project Director Guy Robertson Thursday was advised by Washington that plans have been developed to permit Japanese in the United States to send 25-word messages of a personal nature to friends or relatives in Japan on the Gripsholm, which was due to sail from the Eastern seaboard on Sept. 1. The messages will be flown to the Gripsholm at Rio de Janeiro. To be included in the shipment the messages must reach the postoffice in Washington for collection by the American Red Cross not later than 9 a.m. Monday Sept. 6. Messages will be subject to censorship and must be in the English language to permit rapid censorship. They should not exceed 25 words in length.

In order to facilitate sending the messages, all messages from Heart Mountain should be turned in at the high school study hall (entrance north doors) between 8:30 a.m.-3 p.m. on Friday to allow sufficient time for mailing to Washington.

Regular forms will be available at the high school study hall for transmitting the messages. The messages will not be sent individually. All will be sent to Washington together. No postage will be required.
