Several cases of severe burns due to carelessness and negligence have been reported. An 11-year old girl recently suffered second degree burns on both feet and will be hospitalized for several months. Unless a large number of people become immediately aware of this problem, any resident could easily be crippled for life from burns, the chief nurse said.
