### Evidences Inspect Conditions in Sugar Beet Area

Four Heart Mountain residents, Tom Furuichi, Yasutaro Oku, Nasura Matsuzaki and Suoo Okada made a trip over the Lovell, Wyoming, and Billings, Montana, sugar beet territories last Thursday, Friday and Saturday to inspect the crop, and to see first-hand the conditions under which seasonal workers will operate this year.

Persons considering going out for the harvest are urged to talk with these men and get their versions of contracts and the general condition of the crop. There will be employment for approximately 200 men in the Billings, territory and 20 or more in Lovell. There is also an offer covering 61 acres at Wheatland, 90 miles north of Choyonno.
