Community-Wide Carnival Slated Saturday, Sunday

A center-wide carnival will be sponsored by the community activities department Saturday and Sunday in the high school auditorium. Besides the usual carnival features, a shop will be set up by the adult section for the sale of artificial flowers and embroidery and woodcarving pieces. Proceeds from the carnival will supplement the funds made available through the WRA for improving the recreation program in the center, according to Dave Yamakawa, assistant director of community activities.

Seek 48 Men as Pin-Setters in Spokane

Forty-eight men are sought for permanent work as pin-setters in three modern bowling alleys in Spokane, Wash. Pay is at the rate of seven cents per lane, and the average novice handling one alley can make 60 cents an hour, according to G.H. Shoots, proprietor, who is here this week to recruit help.

An experienced pin-setter handling two alleys can make \$1.20 per hour and more. Busiest hours are from 6 p.m. to 1 a.m., but men may work as long as they like. A dormitory near the alleys with sleeping rooms and lounge will be available for 75 cents per day. Arrangements for meals can also be made.

Shoots emphasized that this is permanent year-round work, and he is interested in making working conditions attractive so that help will remain on a long-term basis. Shoots may be contacted in the outside employment office for the next few days.
