

WARNING: Coal Shipments Curtailed

Faced with a critical shortage of manpower, current shipments of coal for the center have been curtailed, according to Victor J. Ryan, acting assistant project director. The Sheridan Coal company has been notified to discontinue deliveries after this week until present shipments can be disposed of. With an additional nine carloads expected during the week, the crew of 25 assigned men is deemed inadequate to meet the situation.

The volunteer system instituted by the community council has proved to be a disappointment and recruiting of men through regular employment channels has been unsuccessful thus far, Ryan said. Ryan pointed out that unless some satisfactory method could be arranged for the delivery and disposition of the coal, residents would find themselves without fuel for boiler rooms or homes. Future shipments of coal will be based on the number of men available in the coal crew and the speed with which they can handle the work.

Privately Stored Property Reported Damaged

Residents who have property in private storage were urged by Harvay Burnett, evacuee property officer, to check with the storage concerns in regard to their personal belongings as reports of vandalism perpetrated in Los Angeles and other communities have been received here. Pictorial evidence released by the evacuee property office in San Francisco, shows damage to goods stored at the Nichiren Buddhist temple in Los Angeles which could have been avoided if evacuees had left their property in government storage houses, Burnett said. Residents should evacuate form 155 as soon as the segregation movement is completed if they wish to keep their property intact.

Wake for Ex-California Man Set Tonight

Wake services for Shintaro Yasuoka, 75, of 2-6-A, who died at the hospital Tuesday, will be held at 7:30 p.m. tonight at 8-25. Buddhist funeral rites are scheduled for 2 p.m. Saturday, Sept. 25, at 17-25. The Rev. Chikara Aso will officiate at both rites. The deceased, a former Santa Clara, Calif., man, is survived by his widow, Suze; a son, Takashi; a daughter-in-law, Satsue, and grandchildren.
