

Cooperation Asked in Housing Adjustments

"In order to provide housing space for the new residents arriving October 3 on the last train from Tule Lake, many adjustments in the present apartment occupancy will be required. In instances where one person is now living in a small room, it will be necessary to move such persons into bachelor apartments or in the event they desire to join relatives, they can move in with them if a satisfactory arrangement can be reached. Where a small family now remains in a large apartment, they are asked to move to a small unit. Cooperation in this condensing movement is earnestly requested as only by such re-adjustments can sufficient space be provided for our new families."
