Lumber Company Representative Here to Recruit Workers

Joe Mizukami, representing the Otto Lumber company of Laramie, Wyo., is recruiting timber workers at the employment office. He is seeking issei and older nisei in particular for seasonal work. Standard lumbering wages are offered. Workers engaged in cutting, skidding and offbearing can earn between \$175 and \$200 monthly while those doing contract sawing can earn between \$300 and \$400 per month. Living quarters are comfortably furnished and board costs \$1.50 per day. There are 15 Japanese at the camp which is located 35 miles southwest of Laramie. Transportation to Laramie is available at any time. Good food--both Japanese and American--is provided and a Japanese bath has been constructed. Experience is unnecessary. Men with knowledge of caterpillar tractors are desired.

Plan Four Communal Coal Piles for Each Block
