The following message has been received from the United States Army:

"This message is addressed to American men of Japanese ancestry, between the ages of 18 and 38. Many of you have special qualifications which fit you for valuable Army service as soldier interpreters and translators. If you can speak or read the Japanese language and are in good health, you are directed to inquire at once, at the Project Director's office of this Center, as to when you can meet with an official Interviewing Team from Camp Savage, Minnesota, visiting this Center on about December 8 and will remain for 2 or 3 days."
