Offer 15 Nisei Students to Enter Nebraska College

An offer for 15 students to enter the Union college at Lincoln, Neb., for the semester beginning January 17 was received by Virginia Lynn, vocational counselor. Students must be members of the Seventh-Day Adventist church which supports the school. There are already 15 Japanese American students enrolled.

For students requiring financial assistance, work is provided on the campus. If a maximum of 30 hours a week for men and 25 hours a week for women are worked, expenses for men can be reduced from \$495.76 to \$150, and for women from \$455.44 to \$175.

The Union college, an arts and science college, is a member of the association of American colleges and is accredited by the North Central association of churches.
