

Transfer of Community Enterprises Certificates Must Be Reported

Certificates of indebtedness for shares of the earnings for the first fiscal year may be transferred to other individuals but the transfer will not be complete until the shares, properly signed, are brought to the community enterprises office where a reissuance to the purchaser is made, Thomas T. Sasahara, chairman of the board of trustees, announced.

The certificate states, "This certificate is transferable only on the books of the association with the provision that a new certificate in the same series be issued therefor to the transferee by the association." The cooperation of all residents in this matter was requested by Sasahara.
