

### Relocation Team to hold Meetings

A visual story of relocation featuring a motion picture in sound and color of relocated evacuees and a photographic display with maps and charts of relocation areas will be told at the Pagoda theatre in block 29 next Monday evening at 7:00. The program will be repeated Tuesday evening at the Buddhist church, Wednesday evening at the Christian Church in block 22 and at the high school auditorium on Thursday evening.

Harold S. Fistere, relocation supervisor in Cleveland, Robert Cullum, relocation supervisor of New York, Dr. P. A. Webber, relocation officer of Salt Lake city, and Abe Fischler of the Washington reports office will comprise the team putting on the programs.

Several scenes in the movie were taken at Heart Mountain and several former residents here are featured in the film. Dr. Webber, an expert in the Japanese language, will speak in Japanese. No admission will be charged.
