

Three General Meetings Slated by Relocation Teams

A capacity crowd attended the meeting held last night at the Pagoda theatre.

Speaking at these meetings will be Robert Collum, relocation supervisor for the New York area; Harold S. Fister, supervisor for the Cleveland, Ohio area, and Dr. P. A. Webber, WRA officer at Salt Lake city. Abe Fischler of the Washington reports office will be in charge of the photographic display which includes shots of former heart mountaineers. Movies of evacuees at their jobs in the east will also be shown.
