Final Meeting of Relocation Team Set Tonight

As a climax to their four-day stay at Heart Mountain, the relocation team will present its final program in the high school auditorium at 7 p.m. tonight. Packed houses have greeted the speakers on each of the first three nights and it was necessary to turn away many late-comers.

Particularly interesting to the young and old alike are the two pictures in sound and color, "The Way Ahead" and "The Harvest Parade". The first picture draws many chuckles as several former Heart Mountain residents flash across the screen. It shows relocated evacuees at various jobs throughout the east end, with Heart Mountain as a setting, it follows a couple through the process of obtaining an indefinite leave. Readily identified are Joe Carroll, relocation officer; Claud Gilmore, assistant relocation officer; and Victor Ryan, assistant project director. After being cleared by these officers, the couple is shown bidding farewell at the front gate before boarding the Burlington bus for their new home.

Issai and Nisei were surprised at the excellent command of Japanese shown by Dr. P.A. Webber as he spoke in Japanese to bring the story of relocation to the older residents. In a humorous vein, he tells how he learned to like "miso-shiru" as a pre-entertaining reference to his odd experiences in Japan.
