Service Provided by Housing Division Discontinued

Because of the recent reduction in the number of project employees, the service previously provided by the housing department in moving families and their household possessions has now been discontinued, R. Howard Embree, head of the housing division, announced.

Those families authorized to move to another apartment will arrange with the housing office in block 21 for use of the truck, Embree said. Except in welfare cases, the loading and unloading of their personal effects will be done by the families themselves.
