

Tule Lake Resident Sentenced in Liquor Case

Pleading guilty to charges of possessing a still and "sake" mash, John Sasaki Kazuso, 33, of Tule Lake was sentenced by Federal Judge Martin I. Welsh to a year's imprisonment and fined \$600, according to word received here.

Kazuso began to cry when Wallace Shepard, his defense counsel, asked for leniency on the plea Kazuso's wife is ill with tuberculosis in the Tule Lake camp. Asaichi Walter Imai, 33, another Tule Lake Japanese, pleaded not guilty to theft of government foodstuffs at the camp and his trial was set for March 14. Three other Japanese received one-year sentences last week in the federal court here on charges of possession of untaxed liquor.
