

Main Gate Passes to Depot Available

Douglas M. Todd, acting project director, announces that in the future any one wishing to visit the depot to bid farewell to friends or relatives, or to conduct other justifiable business, may readily do so merely by securing a main gate temporary pass from any division or section head, any internal security officer, or the high school and grade school principals.

He pointed out that this minor control is required only for the reason that it is necessary to maintain adequate records of departures and arrivals in the center since such information is necessary to provide total center population records which have a direct bearing on other project operations, particularly mess hall and issuance of rationed food items.
