Residents Warned of Distilling and Selling Liquor

Residents were warned by Harris M. Shiota, acting project attorney, that there are severe penalties for distilling or selling liquor within the center.

The penalty set forth under Wyoming laws, Code 59-13, states as follows:

"Any person who shall manufacture or rectify any alcoholic beverage without holding a license authorizing the manufacture or rectifying thereof or who shall sell any alcoholic or malt liquor without holding a license or permit authorizing the sale thereof, or who shall possess a still without holding a manufacturer's license, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not more than two thousand dollars of which may be added imprisonment in the county jail for not more than ten months and such equipment as he possesses and in illegal use shall be confiscated by the state and disposed of as directed by the court."
