Twelve Heart Mountain nisei who failed to report for selective service examinations as ordered on March 7 were taken into custody over the week-end on warrants issued last Wednesday at Cheyenne by U. S. Commissioner H. S. Reynolds, it was announced by the local selective service officials.

The men are being held in Cody, where, according to Reynolds at the time of issuing the warrants, they will receive hearings before the U. S. Commissioner.

Shoyu Distributed to Residents

The food committee of the community council announced that 376 kogs of shoyu received from the Japanese Red Cross were distributed Thursday to mess hall '30' of every block. It was issued in proportion to the population of the blocks, the committee said.

Blocks 1, 2, 8, 14, 29 and 30 received 19 kogs each. Blocks 6, 9, 12, 15, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 27 and 28 were issued 20 kogs each, while blocks 7 and 25 received 7 and 15 kogs, respectively.

Rosettlers Reminded to Make Applications Early for Shipping Property

Harvey Burnett, evacuee property officer, reiterated that residents contemplating relocation must make application for shipment of their property or personal effects well before or at the time of departure from the center at the evacuee property office in the Sentinel building.

There is no provision made whereby the shipment allowance at Government expense may be requested after departure unless relocators have made application prior to leaving the center to have their property forwarded to them, Burnett said.
