Rulings Ease Shipment of Evacuee Property

Administrative instructions pertaining to evacuee property have been revised to provide for shipment of household and personal effects belonging to an evacuee and his immediate family from the center to the relocation point of the evacuee by the WRA, it was announced by Harvey Burnett, evacuee property officer. The ruling will apply after the evacuee has utilized all baggage privileges to which a relocatee and his immediate family are entitled to under the personal transportation tickets, he said.

Another provision has been made for the shipment of farm machinery and equipment, not to exceed 5000 pounds in weight, which the evacuee may own and have stored in the evacuated area and which he wishes to transport to his new place of relocation, according to Burnett. In this event it will be necessary to obtain the approval of the relocation office serving the community in which the evacuee relocates, certifying that the use of such tools, equipment or fixtures, is essential to the success of the evacuee's relocation. The approval of the project director must also be obtained through the evacuee property office.

Burnett said that such requests may be presented at the time the evacuee is relocating or after he has relocated. However, no payment or reimbursement for previous payments may be made to or on behalf of an evacuee who has shipped such equipment prior to the effective date of the revision, he pointed out.

Provision has also been made regarding shipment of tools, equipment or fixtures necessary to the evacuee's trade, business or profession, but no definite limitation has been fixed at the moment upon the weight limits permitted in shipments of this nature, Burnett declared.

WRA Sanitation Engineer Lauds Clean-up Campaign

The clean-up week serves to eliminate unsanitary conditions, reduce fire hazards, promote general safety and improve living surroundings, Robert P. Lowe, WRA sanitation engineer, stated while visiting the center this week. As a special inducement to girls working as maids, the hotel has undertaken to furnish board and room at the above figure. For this purpose a whole section of guest rooms, with twin beds, steam heat and private baths has been converted into a dormitory for their exclusive use. Two of the rooms have been tastefully furnished as social rooms. The meals are served in a large, pleasant cafeteria. A resident housemother looks after the welfare of the girls, following regulations very similar to those of a YWCA dormitory. At the end of six months the girls will have been given transportation to and from their home center, plus \$3.00 per day travel expenses for one way. This may be used for a visit home or be kept by the worker as a cash bonus.
