

### Residents Must Report Holdings in Foreign Countries

Residents owning foreign bonds or other foreign securities, having bank deposits in a foreign country, or possessing other foreign property should contact the project attorney's office in the Sentinel building, to fill out Treasury department form TFR-500, if they have not already done so. Reports must be filed not later than June 15.

Any person otherwise required to report is exempt if his foreign property had a total value of less than \$10,000 on May 31, 1943, measured by "cost or face value" or "market or estimated value," whichever is higher. The exemption does not apply to foreign bonds payable in United States dollars, which must be reported regardless of value.

Persons are not to confuse form TFR-500 with form TFR-300, which may have been filed about two years ago. Filing of a report on TFR-300 does not excuse anyone from filing a report on form TFR-500.

### Twenty-four Hour Notice Needed to Process Authorization Passes

Residents who desire to leave the center for a day should apply to the social welfare department at least 24 hours in advance, Howard Embree, associate counselor, announced. This is necessary because considerable time is required to process the authorization passes, he said.

### Request Dedication Tunes to be Played on Mothers Day

As a special Mothers day feature, the technical department will play request dedication tunes to mothers 10 a.m. to 12 m, this Sunday, weather permitting, through the public address system to be constructed at community activities headquarters, Ed Morihiro, technical department supervisor, announced.

Residents may bring in requests for certain tunes to the technical department office at 16-N until Sunday. The numbers will be played in the order received and if the number requested is unavailable a substitution will be made. However, persons may bring in their own records if they desire, Morihiro said.
