

Eleven Enlisted Reservists Called For Active Duty

Eleven enlisted reservists from Heart Mountain who were called for active duty in the U. S. Army left for processing at Ft. Logan, Colo., Monday morning, it was announced by center draft officials. Saburo Kawamura, 2-19-C; Pvt. Joe Y. Kumagai, 28-20-C; Pvt. John M. Miyamoto, formerly of 30-15-D, who relocated to North Ogden, Utah; Pvt. Motomu Nakasako, 6-11-E; Pvt. John T. Okumura, 30-6-C; and Pvt. Akira Washio, 20-20-D.

As the three residents who were called previously for active duty, the group will report to the Infantry replacement training center, Camp Blanding, Fla.

To honor twenty-five inductees leaving for induction into the army at Ft. Logan, a farewell ceremony will be held 8:30 a.m. Thursday by the flag pole in front of the administration building. Victor Ryan, assistant project director, will make the main address while Saburo Nakashima, chairman of the community council will speak on behalf of the evacuees. Dave Yamakawa, assistant supervisor of community activities, will be chairman. Music will be furnished by the Boy Scout drum and bugle corps.
