More Details of Tule Lake Shooting Announced

Additional details concerning the fatal wounding of Shichi James Okamoto, 30, former Heart Mountain resident, by a member of the military police at the Tule Lake segregation center last Wednesday was revealed here yesterday by a teletype sent from Dillon S. Myer, national WRA director.

According to the wire, Okamoto was driving a truck returning from the project farm to the center when he was stopped by the sentry outside the gate. As he approached, the sentry first struck him with the butt of a gun and then shot him at close range. Okamoto was taken to the center hospital Wednesday afternoon and died there Wednesday night.

The reason for the shooting is not clear as yet, Myer said. Army authorities at the center have arrested the sentry and are conducting an investigation.

There is no sign of a disturbance in the evacuee community at Tule Lake, Myer added.

Additional facts will be released as they become available.

Special "Back" Gates to be Used by Hikers

To conform with instructions received from the Washington WRA office, records of residents departing and returning from the center to hike in the project area will be kept by means of three special "back" gates, starting Thursday, it was announced by George D. Doihl, statistician.

The gates have been constructed on the south, west and north ends of the center area and persons departing are requested to pass through the gates, leaving their names and addresses with the clerk who will be at each station from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. Red identification buttons will be issued to each individual hiker upon departure and they must be checked in when the person returns.

Residents who plan to leave before the clerks are present in the morning are asked to get their red buttons on the previous day. Those who return to the center after the clerks are gone in the evening are to turn in their buttons on the following morning to the statistics division in the administration building.

It was emphasized by Doihl that the reason for the new procedure is not to limit the movement of the residents but to provide a constant check on where residents are at all times in case of emergency and for a check whenever a person becomes lost. Another reason for the ruling, he pointed out, was for the purpose of public relations.

Agriculture workers of the project farm will still use work passes, which will be turned in each morning at the main or "back" gates for red buttons.

A change in the use of authorization passes will also be effective Thursday, according to Doihl. Hereafter, the passes will be turned in at the main gate in return for blue identification buttons which are to be presented when the evacuee returns to the center.

Unfilled Seasonal Job Offers to be Withdrawn

Residents planning to go out on seasonal leave should register at the outside employment office as unfilled job offers will be withdrawn for recruitment in other centers, Joe Carroll, relocation officer, announced.

Orders have been received for approximately 500 men, mostly for cannery and agricultural work in Utah and Idaho. Men are also needed in Montana, Wyoming, Oregon, Washington and Colorado. Raleigh Serle, Julius Quintana and John Phelps, War Foods Administration recruiters, may be contacted at the outside employment office.

Foreign Bonds and Property Must be Reported

Residents owning any foreign bonds, regardless of value, payable in U. S. dollars or foreign property of any kind with a value of \$10,000 or more must file a report on form TFR-500 not later than June 15 at the project attorney's office, it was announced by Donald T. Horn, acting project attorney.

Willful failure to file a report subjects a person to criminal penalties, Horn said.

Final Certificates of Indebtness Payments to be Made Around June 12

The last payment of refunds to holders of certificates of indebtedness (blue notes) will be made around June 12, Thomas T. Sashihara, chairman of the board of trustees, announced. An amount of about \$22,000, which represents the total earnings of the last fiscal year, will be paid.

Photographer Will be in Center Every Wednesday

所内に於ける家畜取締規則

ハート山轉住所内に於ける家畜取締に関する  
今回參事會からたる初回規則を發表した。

第一條 公衆衛生の見地から 本規則は所内居住者一般の衛生と保安を増進せんがために制定したものなり。

第二條 家畜其の他の動物の飼育禁止 德の家畜類、其他鳥類、齧齒類、昆蟲類、有毒爬虫類及び昆蟲類を室肉、即肉、若しくはハウクの附近に於て飼育するのを禁止す 但し下記の障礙に明記あるものを除く。

第三條 持主の定義 何人とも犬猫を所有、或は習慣的に庇護し自家に居らるゝ又は日幸銅育する者を其等犬猫の持主と認め本規則の責に該當すべしとの認定す。

第四條 登録 所内警察署は年二回所内犬猫數を調査上許しその都度委細をセシテ紙上に發表して持主に知らめたら上其等を登録せしむるは警察署の義務措す。

第五條 登録手の發行 所内警察署者は各大猫の性札番号、年齢、種類、持主の姓名及び住居等を明記せる帳簿を作製し其の金銅附札を持主に交付し持主はこれを登録され大猫の頭に縫附し置くべし。

第六條 無登録の大猫は捕獲 前條規定に依る登録なき大猫は公衆の煩累物と認め警察署は其等興奮録の大猫を捕獲し五日間で保函すべし。

第七條 請求なき犬猫の處置 料頭の規定

に従り保函されたる犬猫にて五日以内に持主より請求なき場合は警察署の通宣と認める處置を取るべし。

第八條 危険性犬の處置 警察署長は公衆安全のため必要と認めたる時は危険性のある犬の持主に對し其の犬を即肉に監禁す。

第九條 口輸を勧むべき事を命令すことをあらへし。

如何なる太にも上記命令を受けたるも猶完全な口輸を欲むせずして所外を彷徨せしむる時は規則実行官吏は軍兵によりて殺することありべし。

第十條 盛り時の北大 北大の時毒にて其の太の盛り時假令登録寄あり又口輸の有無に拘らず所内を彷徨せしむる時は其の又は規則実行官により撲滅せらるべし。

第十一條 識別札 大猫登録の時警察署より識別札を下附せらるゝ右を積費として識別札の賣費用のみ納附すべし。

第十二條 刑罰 何人とも本規則を犯し或は之に應ざる者に輕罪に相當するものと認めらるべし 終り
