

Cash Register Receipts to be Tabulated Starting Next Week

Pink cash register receipts issued by community enterprises during the period from August 1, 1943 to July 21, 1944 will be tabulated at the following places August 3, 4, 7, 8, 9 and 10 from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., according to Ted Okamoto, chief accountant; recreation hall, 8-25-S; recreation hall, 20-26-N; and the community enterprises main office.

Patrons should bring one of their old receipts in order to have their account numbers checked, Okamoto said.
