Residents Should Notify Draft Boards of Changes of Address

Residents who are subject to Selective Service are required to keep their draft boards notified at all times of changes of address, it was announced by the local draft office. Upon leaving the center on any type of leave, they should notify their home draft boards and if their papers have been transferred to the Powell board, notices should be sent to both the original board and Powell.

The Selective Service office in the Sentinel building will assist in the handling of any problems pertaining to the draft, it was said.

Shoe Stamps Again Available at Administration Building

Shoe stamps equivalent to airplane stamp #2 have arrived and are now available at the shoe ration window in the administration building, according to Virgil Payne, social welfare head. To avoid confusion, residents are asked not to apply for stamps for members of the family on seasonal short-term or indefinite leaves. Only a member of the family will be issued stamps for other members of the immediate family, Miss Payne said.

Vocational Apprenticeship Training Offered to Residents

Residents not employed, desiring a change in employment or interested in gaining training and experience in a specified field are urged by Walter C. Schlosser, supervisor, to register immediately for the vocational apprenticeship training program at the night school office.

Opportunities are available at present in the following fields: bookkeeping-accounting, clerk stenography, dictation, electrician, nurse's aide, shoe cobbler, telephone operator, pharmacy, plumbing, and machine shop work.

With numerous openings available now, job assignments are sometimes made before the completion of the eight-week course, Schlosser said.
