CE Board of Trustees Decides Against Scholarship Fund

Acting on the opinion of Phillip Glick, solicitor general of the WRA, the board of trustees of the community enterprises decided not to establish the \$2400 scholarship fund at a special meeting Friday, Thomas Sashihara, chairman, announced.

In answer to the inquiry made by the trustees as to the legality of donating money to the scholarship fund, it was Glick's opinion that the trustees were not authorized to formulate such a fund, Sashihara added.

He will offer family relocation opportunities and at the end of 18 months or 2 years when the job will probably be over workers will have a chance to either lease or buy land nearby.

The wages for work in the mills are 60¢ to 75¢ hour, depending on the location of the mill. Men may work as much as 57 hours per week with time and half over 40. Women will be paid the same rates but are allowed to work only 48 hours per week.
