

Two-Day Community Carnival to Open Saturday

The huge carnival sponsored by the community activities division will open its doors 1:11 p.m. Saturday and Sunday at the high school gym. On Monday, a post-carnival dance for couples only will be held at the same locale.

Food and concession booths will be handled by the Y organizations assisted by the USO, Scouts, Camp Fire Girls and other center groups. In order to avoid confusion, script books will be sold at \$1 each in 5 cent units for use at the booths. Residents are urged to buy them in advance at the CA headquarters, 16-N, to avoid any last-minute rush.

In line with other community activities, the two theatres will cancel all showings on Sunday. On Saturday, there will be an afternoon matinee and one showing at 7 p.m.
