15 Carloads of Coal Expected This Week

A check into the coal situation reveals that the coal has not been received so far this week due to a traffic tie-up at the Laurel, Mont., division point, according to Lundgren T. Main, supply officer. Main, who has been in constant contact with railroad freight agents, has ascertained that 15 carloads of coal consigned to Heart Mountain are due to move out of the Laurel freight yards this morning.

Because the expected carloads of coal will be more than the coal crew can handle, the block managers are working on a plan for volunteer workers to haul coal on Saturday afternoon and Sunday if necessary to get sufficient coal into the area, Main stated. Plans provide that one coal truck, which will be manned by eight volunteers, will be assigned to each block.

Residents interested in working on the volunteer crew should contact their block managers. Persons wishing permanent assignments on the coal crew should see the internal employment office, Main said.

It is requested that the coal shovels which were not turned in last week by the volunteer workers be brought to the coal yards.
