

23 Girls Wanted Immediately at Curtiss Candy Company

Twenty-three girls or women are needed immediately at the Curtiss Candy company plants in Chicago. For the first week, the minimum wage scale is 50 cents per hour for 8 hours with time and a half for overtime after 40 hours. After the first week, the girls usually make more than the 50 cents per hour and whatever is made over that amount is paid. Within two or three weeks, the girls are making on an average of \$30 per week or better. Housing for girls is available at a boarding house operated by Mr. and Mrs. Matsumoto, formerly of Rohwar, Ark. Prior to evacuation they resided in Lodi, Calif. The second floor of the house is reserved for girls. Three girls will occupy one room on a weekly basis of \$12 per week including board.
