Jobs Available at Clinton Bridge Works in Iowa

Openings for welders and trainees are available at the Clinton Bridge Works in Clinton, Iowa. The wage schedule for four groups is as follows:

Group 1--Wage range from 92 cents to \$1 hour. In order for an applicant to reach the top of this bracket, it is necessary that he pass the flat, vertical and overhead tests, and must also be able to read a blueprint.

Group 2--The minimum starting wage is 80 cents with a maximum of 90 cents. In order to be rated in group 2, the applicant must pass both the flat and vertical tests.

Group 3--Wage range from 70 cents to 79 cents. In order to obtain the minimum rate it is necessary that the applicant pass the flat test.

Group 4--Include welder trainees with a wage range from 60 cents to 70 cents.

Tests will be given an applicant upon entering the shop. Applicant's failure to pass the flat test means he must wait another 30 days before taking the next test, 60 days for failure in vertical test, and 90 days for failure in overhead test. Workers get all the overtime they want. Men over 26 employed in this company are exempted from the army.
