Changes in Postal Rates Announced

Changes in money order, insured, COD and special delivery rates will become effective tomorrow, but rates for first class, air mail, third and fourth class rates are still in effect, according to Ernest T. Ebert, local postmaster. First class mail will remain at three cents per ounce or fraction thereof. Air mail remains at eight cents per half ounce or fraction thereof. Air mail to soldiers overseas remains at six cents per half ounce or fraction thereof and is limited to two ounces.
