Do you wear eye glasses? Have you ever stopped to think where they are manufactured? Well, I will tell you. The American Optical company, located in Southbridge, Mass., is the largest manufacturer of lens and frames in the United States and has selling agents the country-wide. 5 to 10 Model Makers for spectacle frames. Must have knowledge of what is practicable for large scale manufacturing. Must have high degree of hand and finger dexterity. Girls inspection work starts at 50 cents per hour--then piece work which can average \$35 to \$45 week of 60 hours.

FPC Members Found Guilty of Conspiracy

Heart Mountain members of the Fair Play committee who faced a federal court jury in Cheyenne during the last ten days, were found guilty of conspiracy to violate the selective service act, project officials learned late today. James Omur, English editor of the Kooky Shimp, was acquitted.

Following sentences were pronounced by the court: Minoru Tamasa and Ben Wakaye, now serving a 3-year sentence for draft evasion, two years in prison to run concurrently; Guntaro Kubota, two years, Isamu Horino, Kiyoshi Okamoto, Frank Emi and Paul Nakadate, four years. The court refused to grant bond.
