Following sentences were pronounced by the court: Minoru Tamesa and Ben Wakaye, now serving a 3-year sentence for draft evasion, two years in prison to run concurrently; Guntaro Kubota, two years, Isamu Horino, Kiroshi Okamoto, Frank mmi and Paul Nakadato, four years. The court refused to grant bond.
