Eiichi Sakauye, chairman of the block managers, has received the following information from F. de Amat, consul of Spain in San Francisco:

"The Spanish embassy has advised this office that it would be greatly appreciated if you, as the spokesman, will make it clear to the Japanese nationals residing at the Heart Mountain center, that the lists being compiled by the American authorities of the names and addresses of said nationals" next of kin in Japan, are the result of a reciprocal agreement entered into by the Japanese and American governments.

"The object of the survey is to facilitate the drawing up of the repatriation lists, since there are numerous individuals with identical first and last names, and the only means of checking which are the right persons is by reference to the next of kin in Japan."
