New Ruling Issued for Use of Mass Halls for Societies

Because of flagrant disregard for existing rules and regulations governing the use of mass halls for social purposes, permits for dances will be issued only when two accredited adults of the block assume all responsibility for the proper conduct of the dance. David Yamakawa, assistant supervisor of community activities, announced. For recreation hall dances, the block manager or councilman will take charge. Unless these rules are observed, permits for all future dances will be revoked, Yamakawa emphasized. Complaints have been received from various sources necessitating this move and young people have been asked to refrain from jeopardizing their own recreational program, he added.

Messages Accepted for British Internees in Philippines

Messages may now be accepted from United States residents for British civilian internees known to be in the Philippines on the same basis as messages are being accepted for United States civilian internees. Period for acceptance of messages by chapters is extended through December 15.

Arrangements have been completed for Red Cross representatives in the Philippines to accept messages or replies from liberated United States prisoners of war and United States and British civilian internees in the Philippines pending establishment of regular communication facilities. These return messages will be routed through Red Cross chapters for delivery.

Many of the messages now being received for transmittal to the Philippines contain only 24 words. These messages need not be limited except by space available on each side of Form 1816.
