"Everything Is Nice in California", Says Sakauye

"Everything is really nice in California," wrote Eiichi Sakauye, former assistant farm superintendent, who is in San Jose on a short term leave. He is expected to return here soon. The letter read in part:

"As I see it from this side of the continent, the climate is at its best by government test. The winter is just beginning here in San Jose. Everything is really nice and green.

"I have had a very pleasant trip to California. We have not encountered a single unpleasant incident. We have stopped in Oakland, Berkeley and San Francisco for a short length of time before coming to San Jose. Everybody has been very nice to us. Perhaps they mistook us for Chinese, anyway everything is nice in the land of sunshine."

"Housing is really tight regardless of a barn or mansion. Another thing the evacuees must take into consideration is that their homes or farms are not the way they had left them. Since everyone has made money in the last few years, the farms are hard to lease. So it would be difficult for the evacuees to get started here unless a government agency is set up here to take up various affairs before the evacuees return to California."
